FX-120 is placed in the field in a similar fashion to asphalt. The mixed material is resistant to oil, gas, grease, salts and mild acids. **FX-120** is extremely economical when compared to Preformed Crossing Units or cast in place Urethane Grouts.



Note that surrounding concrete has cracked, however also notice the cracks did not reflect through **FX-120 Elastomeric Mortar**. **FX-120** has maintained uniform color and texture since its initial installation in 1992.
